Subject: Mark-to-Market rule change

Sir:

I favor a <u>limited</u> revision of mark-to-market accounting rules that would allow a bank or financial institution to write down the value of an asset to market value at the rate of 10% mark down over 10 quarters (i.e. 2-1/2 years).

This would allow a reasonable time for markets in turmoil to stabilize so a reasonable market value could be established for assets in "frozen" or illiquid markets.
