

SEC Announces EDGAR System Upgrade: 2017 GAAP Taxonomy No Longer Supported

On June 10, 2019, the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) announced that the EDGAR system was upgraded to Release 19.2 and no longer supports the 2017 US GAAP Financial Reporting Taxonomy, 2014 Document and Entity Information (DEI) Taxonomy, 2017 Exchanges (EXCH) Taxonomy and 2016 Currencies (Currency) Taxonomy.
