XBRL Resources for Academics and Filers on FASB Website

The FASB staff recently added new resources for academics that focus on the academic community's use of eXtensible Business Reporting Language (XBRL) data. Included on the Academics Use of XBRL page (Academics Page) are XBRL training programs for academics such as those presented at the American Accounting Association, links to the FASB Taxonomy (XBRL) Resources, and an invitation for academics to participate in the XBRL Taxonomy Advisory Group. In addition to the Academics Page, accessibility of resources has been improved to assist filers in applying the validation rules included in the FASB XBRL US Data Quality Committee's Rules Taxonomy (DQCRT). The DQCRT webpage is intended to help increase a filer's exposure to and use of the Data Quality Committee's (DQC) validation rules provided by XBRL US. The webpage provides links to the DQC's validation rules that are included with the annual US GAAP Financial Reporting Taxonomy release, related technical guides, and downloadable versions of the DQCRT (that require XBRL-enabled software to review).
